# Exclusive Features of the Navigation system



## 1. Intersection view screen

The Intersection view screen displays a view of the upcoming intersection and which lane you should be driving. This is helpful when the user is driving through the confusing intersections.



## 2. Alternative routes

To check the alternative routes, drivers can choose the destination and then press "Routes". The system will provide the alternative routes (if available) and the user can choose the route as per his/her preference.



## 3. Finding nearby Honda dealers

User can find Honda dealer/service center and set it as a destination. User needs to select Honda icon on the screen and then select the desired destination from the list.



## 4. Viewing the current location information

User can easily and quickly check out the detail of their current location. User can "save" the current location and also search for hospitals, police station and gas stations nearby the current location.

## 5. Multiple search methods

Various search methods are available to find the destination. User can search the location using search box or search by category.

# Comparison between the In-Dash Navigation solution and the Smartphone based Navigation solution

## In-Dash Navigation solution

## Smartphone based Navigation solution




- In-Dash solution has a bigger screen size and is easier to use.



- Smaller screen size compared to the In-Dash Navigation solution.



- In-Dash solution gets the power supplied directly from the vehicle's battery. No more battery run out issue.



- The navigation solution in the smartphone consumes lot of battery, hence constant charging of the phone is required.



- In-Dash solution works on the GPS technology and the internet connection is not required to use the navigation feature.
- Since the internet connection is not required, there is no additional cost for the internet connection.



- Smartphone based navigation may not work efficiently in the areas with poor internet connection.
- User needs to pay for the internet connection fee.



- In-Dash solution comes with various features related to navigation such as intersection view screen.



- Limited features available in the smartphone based navigation solution.



- It is easy to type the destination information in the In-Dash navigation solution due to bigger screen size.



- Hard to type the destination information due to the small size of the virtual keyboard available on the smartphone.

## Search for Point of Interest (POI) by category




Step 1 – Select “Where To?”.



Step 2 – Select “Categories”.




Step 3 – Select a POI category from the list, for example “Transit”.



Step 4 – Select a subcategory for example “Airports”.



Step 5 – Select your destination from the list.



Step 6 – Select “Go!”.



Step 7 – The system will calculate and display the route line on the map screen.

## Search for Point of Interest (POI) by entering name



Step 1 – Select “Where To?”.




Step 2 – Select “Categories”.



Step 3 – Select “Search box”.



Step 4 – Enter the name of POI for example “Victory Monument”.



Step 5 – Select your destination from the list.



Step 6 – Select “Go!”.



Step 7 – The system will calculate and display the route line on the map screen.

With new turns, roads and infrastructure coming up every now and then, it is important for the vehicle maps to stay updated. It is as vital as keeping a check on other essentials of vehicles like gas or fuel. An updated map is equipped to give an optimal navigation experience making sure one always reach his/her right destination.

Map updates are essential to give you a better and optimal navigation experience.

The map update includes updated points of interest and roads all which are essential. Maybe you are on a road trip and need to locate the nearest gas station. Or perhaps you are in a new part of town and need to find a route to your destination. These are just few of the scenarios in which an up-to-date map will prove helpful.

Note: When the term update is used, this can either mean the addition of new data or modification of data already existing.

For Honda vehicles with the MapCare program, a user gets free\* 5 years of map updates. This applies to Honda's following car models: New CR-V (2.4 EL 4WD, DT EL 4WD), New Accord (2.4EL, Hybrid TECH) and New Civic (Turbo RS).

The 5 years MapCare subscription is activated the first time customer visits the portal (<https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>) and follows the process to check for a map update or when the car has been driven approximately 322 km (200 miles), whichever comes first.

\*Customer needs to pay service charge to the dealer in case dealer performs the map update process for the customer.

Map Updates include changes of the Points of Interest (POI) and routes. Some examples of Point of Interest are as follows



### ATM/Banks

Updates related to the ATM's and Banks which are helpful to find the ATM's/Banks in vicinity.



### Petrol station

Updates related to the Petrol stations which are helpful in the time of emergency.



### Restaurants

Updates related to the Restaurants so that you can plan your next dinner meeting.



### Hospitals

Updates related to hospitals which are helpful especially in the time of emergency.

Note: When the term update is used, this can either mean the addition of new data or modification of data already existing.

## Updating the Honda Navigation system

The navigation update process will require you to go to your car, then your computer and back to your car to complete the process. To perform these updates, you will need the following:


- 16 GB USB Drive
- High-speed Internet connection
- Up to 4 hours of time

### Step 1 – This step takes about 3 minutes

Start the engine of your car and ensure that it is running during the entire time of the process. Follow the below instructions.



1. Plug in your USB drive with at least 16 GB of available space into the car's USB port.



2. Select "Settings" on Navigation home screen.



3. Select "Device".



4. Select "Update Map".



5. Select "OK".



6. Select "OK" and remove USB drive from USB port.

Note: Please wait 60 seconds before you remove the USB

## Step 2 – This step takes about an hour.

### Download Garmin Express and Map Update

Note: The map download time varies based on internet connection speed and new map region data




1. Open the Honda Navigation Update Website: <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>

Press "Get Started" to see all the map update flow.

Select "View FAQs" to see more general update information.


Press the Language icon to change your language.




2. Press the Language icon and then choose your preferred language.




3. After entering Navigation update page: <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>, press "Get Started".



4. Press "Download Garmin Express".



5. Select "Save" to download GarminExpressInstaller.exe to your computer.



6. GarminExpressInstaller.exe will be downloaded.



7. Once the download is completed, please execute the GarminExpressInstaller.exe file and tick  the checkbox in front of "I have read and agreed to the terms and condition" and then select "Install".




8. The system will install Garmin Express on your computer.




9. Once installation is completed, select "Launch Garmin Express".




10. You can also use the icon to launch Garmin Express.




17. The system will verify and confirm if updated map is available. Press "View Details" to see available update information or press "Install" to start updating process.



18. Read and accept the terms and conditions for performing updates by selecting "Accept".




19. Important notes about the update are shown. Once ready select "Continue".



11. Select "Add a Device".




12. Plug the USB drive into computer's USB port.




13. After device is found, select "Add Device".




14. To register the device now, simply provide your email address. Map Update Notifications can be ticked to inform the next map update. And then Select "Next".




15. A nickname can be entered e.g. Registration number or VIN\* could be used. So a vehicle can be identified at a later date. Select "Finish".




16. Select "Yes".



20. Update download will begin.



21. Building the map and copying files to the USB drive.



22. Update process complete. Remove the USB drive from the computer.

## Step 3 – This step takes about an hour.

### Plug the USB drive into the vehicle USB port.

- You cannot use the same map download for multiple vehicles. This will lock navigation device from working.
- The map update will take up to one hour but may vary based on the map region data. During the map update, your Honda navigation system must not be turned off. Therefore, the engine must be running while the vehicle is parked outside or in a well-ventilated area. Before getting started, familiarise yourself with and follow all applicable laws in your area. Please contact your dealer if have any questions or concerns.



1. Select "Settings" on Navigation Home screen.




2. Select "Device".




3. Select "Update Map".



4. Select "Yes" to continue.



5. Installing the updated map.



6. Update completed. Select "OK" to finish. Remove the USB drive from the USB port.

## Checking Map Version



1. Select "Settings".



2. Select "Map & Vehicle".



3. Select "myMaps".



4. Map region and version is shown. Map version checking process is now completed.

» General Update Information.

- Q How can I tell if I have the latest maps?
- A Please follow steps 1 and 2 of the map update process available on the website <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>.
- Q What do I need to get a map update?
- A You will need a 16 GB USB drive, a high-speed Internet connection and up to 4 hours of time.
- Q How can I tell what map version I have?
- A In the navigation application, you can see your map version by going to Settings > Map & Vehicle > myMaps.
- Q How can I tell what software version I have?
- A In the navigation application, the software version can be found under Settings > Device > About.
- Q Are map updates available on DVD?
- A No, map updates are only available to download. Please follow the instructions provided on the website <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/> to download your map update.

» General Update Information.

- Q How often do new maps come out?
- A New map updates are released once a year.
- Q How do I update the Points of Interest? (Restaurants, Petrol Stations, etc.)
- A Points of Interest are included in a map update.
- Q: Will my “Favourites” be deleted when I update my maps?
- A No, these items will not be deleted when a map update occurs.

» The Update Process.

- Q How long does a navigation update take?
- A The time required will vary based on file size and Internet speed. Please allow up to 4 hours of time to complete this update.
- Q How can I tell that my maps updated successfully?
- A Your Navigation System will display “Update Successful” if the maps were updated successfully.

## » Subscription Questions.

**Q** Do I get map updates?

**A** Honda vehicles with Garmin supplied navigation can receive updates through <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>. To confirm if you have Garmin-supplied navigation, on your navigation application go to Settings > Device > About and check that navigation is being provided by Garmin.

**Q** Do I have to pay for map updates?

**A** For Honda vehicles with Garmin navigation, a user gets 5 years of map updates at no cost\*.

**Q** How much longer will I receive free map updates for?

**A** Garmin Express will display how much time you have left in your subscription.

\*Customer needs to pay service charge to the dealer in case dealer performs the map update process for the customer.

## » Troubleshooting or Reporting Problems

**Q** My car lost power in the middle of an update. What do I do?

**A** Restart the map update process again by following the map update procedure.

**Q** My update won't start when I plug in the USB drive. What do I do?

**A** Delete all files on the USB drive and restart the process from step 1 of the update instructions provided on the website <https://honda.garmin.com/honda/>. If you continue to have this issue, please contact your local dealer.
